3 Who is SAMWUMED?

3.1. SAMWUMED is a financially healthy, fully funded, nationally accredited, and self-administered medical aid scheme which covers approximately 75 000 lives throughout South Africa. It operates within a closed sector namely, local government and associated agencies and employees.

4 Information Collected

- 4.1. Collection of Personal Information
 - 4.1.1. SAMWUMED collects and processes Personal Information to mainly provide access to our services and products, to help improve our offerings and for certain other purposes explained below. They type of information collected depends on the purpose for which it is collected and used. SAMWUMED will only collect information that we need for that purpose.
 - 4.1.2. SAMWUMED directly collects information when provided with personal details, by way of example, when a product or service is purchased from us or when enquiries are submitted to us or when we are contacted. Where possible, SAMWUMED will inform data subjects which information is required by us and which information is optional.
 - 4.1.3. Examples of information we collect includes: -
 - 4.1.3.1. Names;
 - 4.1.3.2. Physical addresses;
 - 4.1.3.3. E-mail addresses;
 - 4.1.3.4. Contact numbers (telephone/ cell number);
 - 4.1.3.5. Any user-generated content, posts and other content submitted to our website.
 - 4.1.4. SAMWUMED also collects information from other sources as explained below.

on this website. SAMWUMED may from time-to-time supply third parties with non-personal or aggregated data for uses in connection with this website.

4.3. Cookies Policy

The term "cookies" refers to cookies and other similar technologies covered by the POPI Act on privacy in electronic communications.

4.3.1. What is a cookie?

Cookies are small data files that browsers place on computers and devices. Cookies help browsers navigate a website and the cookies themselves cannot collect any information stored on computer or files. When a server uses a web browser to read cookies, they can help a website deliver a more user-friendly service. In order to protect privacy, browsers only give websites access to the cookies that that have already been sent.

4.3.2. Why use cookies?

Cookies are used to learn more about the way our content is interacted with and helps SAMWUMED to improve the user experience when visiting our website. Cookies remember the type of browsers used and which additional browser software has been installed. - 5.1.14. Personalisation of website experiences, as well as to evaluate (anonymously and in the aggregate) statistics on website activity, such as the time visited, prior visitations and referral sites.
